

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for this Scholarship, candidates must be a past recipient of the LiUNA Local 183 Scholarship program and must have:

- Minimum 3 years of working experience
- Bachelor's degree
- Fluency in English

Documents to be provided:

- Letter of Employment
- Official Transcript
- Essay detailing how this scholarship opportunity will impact your educational journey and how you plan to give back to the community in the future. The essay should not exceed 500 words in length. Ensure that all sources referenced are properly cited.

SELECTION CRITERIA

The selection process will be conducted by a panel of experts appointed by Porto Business School.

The panel will assess each candidate's academic and/or professional achievements, leadership potential, personal and professional development goals, and essay.

The panel's decision will be final and not subject to appeal.
